Gordon Tip: Endodontic treatment can reduce restorative life expectancy. Some studies show vital restored teeth serve longer than endodontically treated teeth. This finding should motivate dentists to preserve tooth vitality as long as possible by use of direct and indirect pulp capping procedures. When there is not adequate bone thickness for conventional diameter implants, small diameter implants are very adequate, especially for treatment of mandibular edentulism with adequate bone quality. They are a less complicated and less traumatic technique than placing standard diameter implants, and for many procedures, they can serve patients better than larger two-piece implants. PHARMACOLOGY

CR Note: For "super bug" prevention, it is imperative to minimize patient exposure to antibiotics. Clindamycin is no longer appropriate. Many conditions previously thought to require systemic antibiotics actually do not, such as many non-heart-valve-replacement conditions, medical devices (stents, pacemakers, non-weight-bearing implants), etc. Early root canal therapy (RCT), extraction, I&D (incision and drainage), etc., can minimize drug exposure. Antibiotics alone will not replace definitive treatment, including extraction, RCT, pus drainage, and elimination of the pathogen. Critically evaluate your own preps and impressions to minimize flaws. The convenience of a digital workflow should not compromise excellent clinical fit and function of crowns.

CR Note: Zirconia types and their service longevity indicate clinical uses. *Physical properties present in tetragonal (3Y) zirconia impart a "margin of safety"* from fracture not present in the cubic containing (4Y, 5Y, 6Y) and "exceptions" formulations in this study. Based on this, CR suggests the following indications:

- **Tetragonal zirconia:** 1) molars, 2) posterior multi-units, 3) minimal preps, 4) abusive occlusion, 5) occlusal adjustment expected, 6) endo entry expected, 7) high-risk lifestyle, and 8) maximum longevity wanted.

CR Note: Where should I begin bone grafting—posterior or anterior?

- For GPs, the emphasis is on the posterior, single and multiple socket teeth. Molars with prominent root position may have a thin buccal plate requiring facial augmentation.
